Our network for the future

Proprietary fibre-optic core network

- 6,500 km line length, available almost nationwide
- Access to a further 50,000 kilometres fibre infrastructure through our cooperation with GasLINE and DB broadband
- Data transmission with up to 100 Gigabit/sec.
 based on DWDM standard
- Basis for gigabit services from public utility companies, local authorities and internet service providers
- Basis for latency-optimised services such as SD-WAN and real-time applications (e.g. Industry 4.0, Big Data, digital work in the cloud, synchronous mirroring of data centres)


Broadband requirements for local authorities and public utilities

- Only just under **7%** of German households have a fibre-optic connection




The German government has been funding the FttH/B

billion € since 2020.



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

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
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Baden-Württemberg & neighbouring Bavaria: Fibre-optic expansion through sister company
